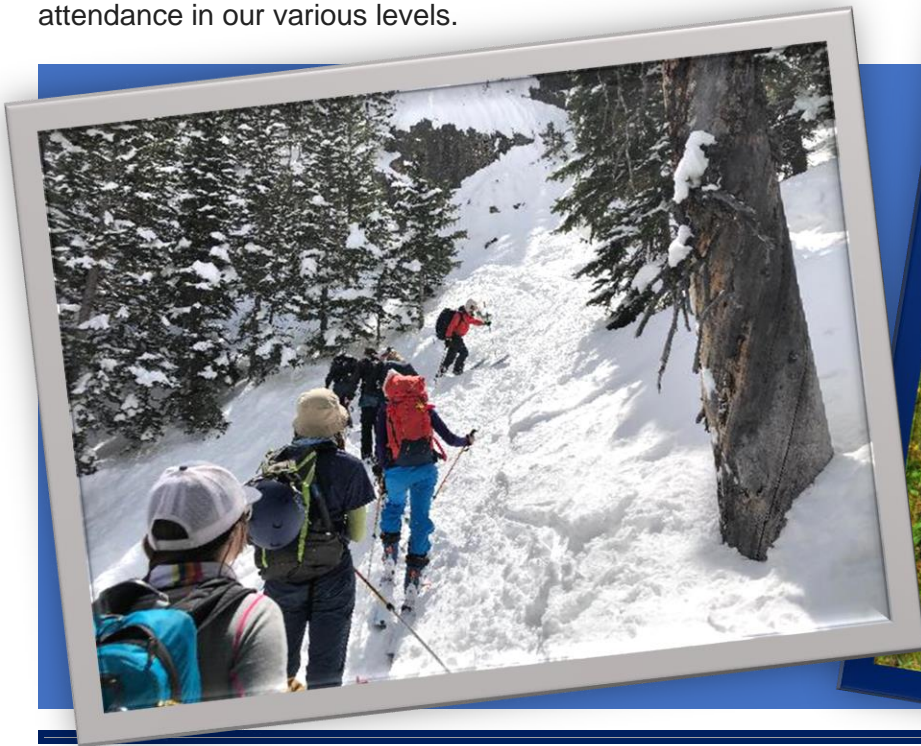

August marked the end of a fun SMBA summer session and return of our annual Crested Butte adventure trip. All of our summer team athletes wrapped up their session with a big last ride from Nederland to Boulder. For some of our younger team riders, the 30+ mile ride marked their longest ride to date. The big ride ended at the SMBA office where our athletes and coaches enjoyed an end of session ice cream social.

After a hiatus in 2020, we celebrated the end of summer with the return of our annual Crested Butte adventure

athlete registration. Top coaches will include Kasinee Gehring with the U16's, Heath Colon, Arthur Nelson and Anna Birkner. Returning to coach for EMSC and former AVSC athlete and ski star, Alex Maple will join our U16's to assist with continued development with speed elements. Our FIS Team has begun dryland, and we had our first official team meeting earlier this week at the CU Ski Team building. Attending the meeting were our amazing EMSC FIS athletes, along with top skiing talent from CU (Post Grad athletes), and news skiers attending CU. The experience, talent, speed and motivation of this group is inspiring, and our coaches that will be helping out this season will be finalized as we complete interviews into September. Richard Rokos will also be attending our training sessions to help coach, along with various races throughout the season.

Weekend training at Eldora will continue to focus on morning sessions. We will be providing additional information as we learn more from Eldora, along with USSA related to confirmation of race calendar schedules. Our Freestyle and Big Mountain Team, along with Alpine Snowboard (Carve) is gearing up for a solid season, with our top staff returning once again to lead this group back to the podium at regional, national and international levels. EMSC Dryland for all athletes will begin September 1st. Our U16's will continue the progression working into several key strength days at the Alpine Training Center with top strength coach, Connie Sciolino and her motivated staff. As we solidify our lead positions, there may also be opportunities during the week for morning dryland training sessions for athletes with afternoon activity/sports commitments. Our goal is to once again utilize the van transportation model for Team Travel, and home training sessions. Updates from our Safety Committee on policies and procedures will be sent to members to ensure we are providing the safest environment possible for the athletes with EMSC events.

We have a strong group of coaches with too many talents to list that are eager to work with our athletes and get on the slopes. In the meantime, we are psyched to build a new partnership with Ninja Nation for dryland while also introducing new ways to build strength, enhance balance, and get fully conditioned before we take our training onto snow. We are not only teaching the fundamentals of skiing and snowboarding but promoting a healthy lifestyle while reconnecting with nature, and developing a solid base of confidence that can take on into their adulthood and into any career they choose.

intensive AMGA ski mountaineering exam, which tests guides on their ski fundamentals. In exchange, CMS created a customized course for EMSC racers. Over a 3-day weekend in April, U14-U19 athletes achieved their level I AIARE certificate. CMS teaches a complete program curriculum that has been established by the [American Institute for Avalanche Research and Education](#) (AIARE) and are the world's largest and most experienced AIARE provider. This course was taught by highly qualified AMGA guides (some are also Eldora ski patrollers) to help ski racers gain critical knowledge that they can use as they grow and explore the mountains beyond their backyard.



The course took place in Rocky Mountain National Park, which offers terrain for all skiers, including mellow glades, open bowls, steep couloirs and lofty summits. Athletes learned how to make decisions in avalanche terrain, how to prepare for and carry out a backcountry trip, how to understand basic decision making while in the field, and rescue techniques required to find and dig up a buried person (if an avalanche occurs and someone in the party is caught). The athletes actively engage in tour planning, navigation, risk management, critical evaluation, and decision making. They learned how to use AT gear (AT bindings, skins, avalanche rescue equipment) and developed backcountry skills (kick turns, effective skinning techniques, how to ski downhill with a pack and more). The course finished with a culmination of skills on a ski tour with their guides. Stay tuned to learn about future opportunities with the EMSC/CMS educational partnership.

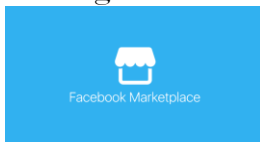
